Levee Vegetation Cutting and Herbicide Treatment

The mission and mandate of the Peninsula Drainage District No.2 is to manage vegetation that are harmful to the integrity and function of the levee system in a manner that is efficient, effective, environmentally responsible, and with careful attention to public and employee safety.

Peninsula Drainage District #2 has contracted with C&R Reforestation to cut and treat the riverward slope vegetation on the Bridgeton Levee. The contractor's crew will cut the levee vegetation starting on or around (depending on weather conditions) July 6, 2010 and should be completed within 5 days.

The contractor will return on or around (depending on weather conditions) July 16, 2010 to apply an herbicide (Garlon 3A) to help control the growth of invasive weeds on the levee.

Peninsula Drainage District No.2 will post notification signs 48 hours prior to the herbicide application. Signs will be removed 48 hours after the herbicide application has been completed.

Garlon 3A is an herbicide registered by EPA (registration # 62719-37) to be used adjacent to waterways.
