

## Sponsorship Scoring Criteria for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 (July 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023)

### Points System (Maximum of 10 points available)

#### 1. Operational Relevancy (2 points maximum)

Does the work of this organization support the Districts' operations?

Examples include organizations that support houseless outreach and education, and/or illegal dumping and hazard materials clean-up within the service area.

- Yes, this community partner currently supports drainage district operations **(2 points)**
- This partner has the potential to support drainage district operations (i.e. program activities address the above, but organization is not currently working with the drainage districts on these issues) **(1 point)**
- None of the above **(0 points)**

#### 2. Equity Criteria (4 points maximum)

Does this event or program support BIPOC or other historically oppressed and/or marginalized communities?

- Yes, this event or program is put on by a BIPOC led organization and the outcome supports direct services for BIPOC community members **(4 points)**
- This event is put on by an organization that is led by another historically marginalized community, and outcomes will produce direct services for that group *OR* this event is put on in direct partnership with BIPOC groups and the outcomes will directly support BIPOC community members. **(3 points)**
- This event is not organized by BIPOC or historically marginalized groups, but outcomes will largely go towards supporting those groups **(2 points)**
- This event is not put on by BIPOC or other historically marginalized groups, but the outcome will partially benefit those groups **(1 point)**
- This event or program is not put on by BIPOC or other historically marginalized groups, and the outcomes/funds generated will not benefit those groups **(0 points)**

#### 3. Flood Education (2 points maximum)

Is this event or program related to flood education or emergency preparedness?

- Yes, flood education and emergency preparedness are central components of this event or program **(2 points)**
- This event, project or program is adjacent to flood risk education and emergency preparedness **(1 point)**
- This event or program is not relevant to flood risk education **(0 points)**

#### 4. Geographical Relevancy (1 point maximum)

Are the Drainage Districts' boundaries relevant to the organization, event, program, or the constituents/beneficiaries?

Examples include organizations that conduct activities within the service area, organizations that are located within the service area, and organizations whose constituents have connection to the service area.

- Yes, our district boundaries/service area are relevant **(1 point)**

- No, our district boundaries/service area are not relevant **(0 points)**

5. Stakeholder Relationship Building **(1 point maximum)**

Does the requesting organization have connections to priority constituents within the managed floodplain? Examples include low-income populations, houseless populations, BIPOC populations, residents or businesses within the managed floodplain, ect...

- Yes, the requesting organization has those connects **(1 points)**
- No, the requesting organization does not have these established connections **(0 point)**

**Scores & Funding Potential:**

**8-10 Points: Up to \$6,000**

**6-7 Points: Up to \$4,000**

**5 Points: Up to \$2,000**

**3-4 Points: Up to \$1,000**

**Less than 3: Consider Not Funding**
